ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, service members must be on active duty and within 180 days of separating from the military.



COMMANDER APPROVAL

Participation requires approval from the service member's unit commander, as it is dependent on mission requirements.



MILITARY PAY & BENEFITS


Participants continue to receive their full military pay and benefits while training, with no cost to the employer.



The Department of Defense (DoD) SkillBridge program allows active-duty service members within 180 days of separation to receive civilian job training, internships, or apprenticeships with approved industry partners and government agencies, providing hands-on experience for a smoother transition to civilian life. During the program, service members continue to receive their military compensation and benefits, while employers gain access to trained talent for future roles.



GAIN VALUABLE EXPERIENCE

TRAINING

Service members gain valuable work experience through internships, apprenticeships, or training programs with approved companies and government agencies.

CAREER PREPARATION

The program connects service members with industry partners and government agencies to build resumes, explore job interests, and acquire skills for high-demand fields.
